8. There are no group entry fees. Premiums for group classes will be one-half of the stated premiums. Only one premium will be paid per exhibitor in group classes. To be eligible for group classes, sheep must have been entered and shown in their respective individual classes.
9. Exhibitors will not be limited to the number of animals they may enter in individual classes but no more than two (2) premiums will be awarded to any one exhibitor per class.
10. A Supreme Champion Ram & Ewe over all breeds will be selected at the end of the show.
 - Any Other Breed (if more than six (6) head are shown of a single breed, they will be granted a separate class in the following year's show)
 - Elite wether Sire & Dam (Note: sheep shown as Elite wether Sire or Dam do not need to be registered or pure breed)

OPEN CLASS SHEEP FITTING CONTEST

CON: SHE – SECT. 4

Superintendent: Bob Winslow & Kay Moyer

1. Open to anyone!
2. Contestants will be provided an unfitted and unwashed sheep.
3. Contestant will be allowed 30 minutes to work on the sheep and do as much as they can to prepare the sheep for the show. Following the initial 30 minutes allowed for preparing the sheep for show, the judge will take additional time in evaluating the contestant's performance. Due to time constraints, participants over the age of 65 will be allowed one bathroom break, other participants can hold it until the end of the demonstration.
4. Judging will be based on the skills demonstrated to prepare the sheep, including correct use of equipment, handling of sheep, and quality of end result. In the interest of time, contestant's attention to things like trimming feet (1 front and 1 hind) and work on "one side of the animal" including the head, will constitute a complete effort.
5. Contestants will be required to supply all the equipment and supplies including brushes, card, hand shears, and blocking table, as needed. Electric clippers will be allowed.
6. The contest superintendent and judge will meet with all contestants prior to the contest to go over specific details and instructions.
7. Each contestant is permitted an assistant to keep the sheep in proper position and from falling from the stand. The assistant may hand equipment to the contestant, but may not help or consult with the contestant in the actual trimming.

LARAMIE COUNTY BRED & FED – BEEF

(MUST BE ENTERED ON ENTRY FORM)

Dept. CON Sect. 5

Superintendent: Dan and Bobbie Frank

1. All exhibitors must abide by all applicable rules and regulations of the Laramie County Fair.
2. The show is open to Laramie County 4-H and FFA members and project animals only. Calves are to have been born and raised in Laramie County during the two most recent years. Calves should be branded with the brand recorded to a Laramie County producer and must be market beef calves only.
3. Any number of calves can be shown.

4. Calves are to be on the fairgrounds for weigh-in (see schedule).
5. Calves are to be checked in with the Superintendent at weigh-in.
6. Steers will be weighed. Classes will be assigned by the Superintendent.
7. If calves are to be shown in Market Beef classes, they must be entered on a separate line on the entry card for the Market Beef class.

1. All exhibitors must abide by all applicable rules and regulations of the Laramie County Fair.
2. The producer/breeder of the lamb must be a legal resident of Laramie County.
3. All hogs must be bred, born, raised and fed within the boundaries of Laramie County (with the exception of boars used in Artificial Insemination programs).
4. All hogs eligible for this show MUST be owned by a Laramie County 4-H or FFA member in good standing according to the by-laws of those organizations.
5. Hogs are to be on the fairgrounds for weigh-in (see schedule).
6. Hogs are to be checked in with the Superintendent at weigh-in.
7. Hogs will be weighed. Classes will be assigned by the Superintendent.
8. If hogs are to be shown in Market Hog classes, they must be entered on a separate line on the entry card for the Market Hog class.

LARAMIE COUNTY BRED & FED — LAMB

1. All exhibitors must abide by all applicable rules and regulations of the Laramie County Fair.
2. The producer/breeder of the lamb must be a legal resident of Laramie County.
3. All lambs must be bred, born, raised and fed

within the boundaries of Laramie County (with the exception of rams used in Artificial Insemination programs).

4. All lambs eligible for this show MUST be owned by a Laramie County 4-H or FFA member in good standing according to the by-laws of those organizations.
5. Lambs are to be on the fairgrounds for weigh-in (see schedule).
6. Lambs are to be checked in with the Superintendent at weigh-in.
7. Lambs will be weighed. Classes will be assigned by the Superintendent.

LARAMIE COUNTY BRED & FED MEAT GOATS

(Must be entered on Entry Form)

1. All exhibitors must abide by all applicable rules and regulations of the Laramie County Fair.
2. The producer/breeder of the Goat must be a legal resident of Laramie County.
3. All goats must be bred, born, raised and fed within the boundaries of Laramie County (with the exception of bucks used in Artificial Insemination programs).
4. All goats eligible for this show MUST be owned by a Laramie County 4-H or FFA member in good standing according to the by-laws of those organizations.
5. Goats are to be on the fairgrounds for weigh-in (see schedule).
6. Goats are to be checked in with the Superintendent at weigh-in.
7. Goats will be weighed. Classes will be assigned by the Superintendent.

BEEF ULTRASOUND CARCASS CONTEST

DEPT. CON – SECT. 9

Superintendents: Dan Frank and Gene Stillahan

1. This contest is open to all 4-H and FFA members in Laramie County with market beef projects.
2. Limit: One (1) 4-H and FFA animal can be entered by each member.
3. Market steers and market heifers are eligible.
4. All animals entered will be scanned by a certified ultrasound technician at weigh-in.
5. Animals will be placed in order by the results of the ultrasound scan based on rib-eye area, back fat, inter-muscular fat and live weight.
