**BREEDING SHEEP**

**THESE RULES APPLY TO BREEDING SHEEP ONLY.**

1. Animals entered in the breed classes of this division should be purebred and must be owned by June 1 of the current year. Age will be computed from Jan. 1. Crossbreds will not be shown in breeding classes. Lambs must have been dropped within the current calendar year.
2. A flock shall consist of one ram, two yearling ewes and two ewe lambs owned by one exhibitor. These animals must have been shown in their respective classes.
3. All breeding sheep, yearlings and over, must be sheared after Jan. 1 of the current year.
4. No sheep may be shown in more than one class except in specified groups. Get of Sire

**LAMB ULTRASOUND CARCASS CONTEST**

DEPT: CON – SECT. 13  
Superintendent – Ron Sutherland

**All lambs entering this contest must be weighed when animal is ear tagged at Archer to enter the ultrasound contest.**

This contest is open to all 4-H and FFA members. It is designed to give a complete carcass evaluation of your live lamb using ultrasound equipment and a computer software package designed by the University of Wyoming Animal Science Department. It will provide performance data on your lamb and how these factors compare to the requirements used by the packing plants to meet the commercial meat marketing business.

1. All lambs entered in the market classes will be eligible for the contest. This means that your market lamb can be entered both in market and sheep carcass contest.
2. All lambs will be evaluated together with no distinction between black faces, speckled face, or white faced lambs.
3. When your lambs are weighed at County Fair, each exhibitor will select one of their best lambs registered in the spring. The exhibitor will take their selected lambs to the designated area. The ear tag will be verified and the weight slips will be recorded and the official entry will be completed.
4. The lamb will be processed and the ultrasound data will be entered and processed by the computer software.

### PEEWEE SHEEP LEADS

### Rules

1. Only gilts or boars farrowed during the current year may be shown. Breeding hogs should be purchased or obtained earlier in the project year and the exhibitor must know the exact birth date.
2. Dates for determining boar and gilt ages:
3. Jr. boar or gilt - farrowed between March 1 and April 30 of current year
4. Sr. boar or gilt - farrowed between January 1 and February 29 of current year.
5. Gilts entered in the breed classes of this division should be purebred and if registered must be registered in the name of the 4- H member. No crossbred boars will be shown. Boars must be purebred and meet registration requirements. Registration papers on boars are required.
